He is married to Shepuya and they are blessed with 7 children and 2 grand-children.

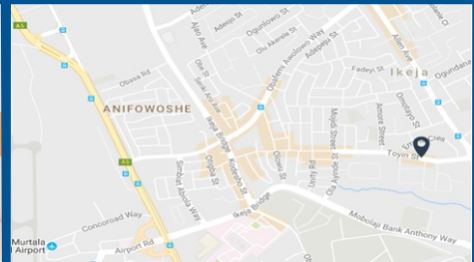
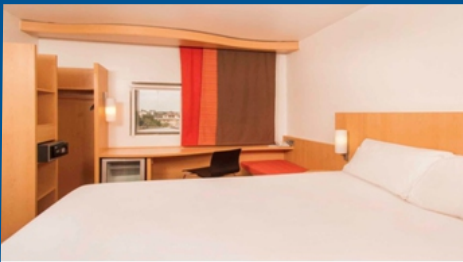
